A Guide to the New Norfolk Syllabus for Religious Education

This full-day course will offer teachers the opportunity to find their way around the new Norfolk Syllabus in the company of the Religious Education Adviser, Helen Matter.

The structure of the syllabus will be unpicked and discussed, including its relationship both to the new National Framework and the old 1997 Norfolk Syllabus. Links will be made with the QCA units of work and suggestions for alternative ways of delivering the requirements considered.

Helpful resources will be on display throughout the course and plenty of opportunities given for question and debate.

Additional Information:-

The new Norfolk Agreed Syllabus 2005 is currently being printed and will soon be available for schools. After the launch on 27th September, the syllabus should also be published on the web.

The syllabus must be implemented by September 2006 so schools are advised to begin preparation now. Both the 1997 and 2005 syllabuses are acceptable during 2005-6.

We hope to run a series of free twilight courses across the county during the autumn term; these will provide a very brief introduction to the syllabus but obviously not offer the depth and support that this day course does.
