This introductory meeting is an opportunity for teachers from all phases to examine the new Syllabus in the company of the RE Adviser, Helen Matter, and colleagues in their own area. We will look simply at the structure of the new syllabus, outline the main changes from the previous Agreed Syllabus and indicate decisions schools will have to make to implement the new legal requirements. There will be a chance to ask questions and talk to colleagues. Useful resources will also be on display.

Many RE subject leaders have already attended a full day's course on the new syllabus and should not need to attend this brief introduction, although welcome to do so, for example to bring colleagues from their schools. Subject leaders who have not yet attended a full day course are encouraged to attend the one entitled: A Guide to the new Norfolk Agreed Syllabus. The next available courses are on 7th December at WNPDC 5HN047 and 9th December at NPDC 5HN046 with a further two courses in the summer term (NPDC - 25 May 2006, WNPDC - 22 May 2006), please refer to the INSET Opportunities booklet in schools in Spring 2006.

A supplementary course for Primary and Middle schools, Beginning to Implement the new Norfolk Syllabus for RE, will run in the summer (NPDC - 26 May 2006, WNPDC - 23 May 2006) refer to INSET Opportunities in Spring 2006. This will look at constructing a scheme of work and creating individual units. It will also investigate links with QCA materials, consider the 'Experiences and Opportunities' the Agreed Syllabus requires and examine the use of the 8 level assessment scale.

Arrangements are also being made for additional courses and network meetings for Secondary RE teachers and Heads of Department.

Please bring your new Agreed Syllabus if possible to the course.
