Briefings for Headteachers of Primary Schools on the new PANDA report and new additional Fischer Family Trust analysis, to support School Self-Evaluation.

These free of charge sessions are a repeat of the briefings held in November 2005 for headteachers who were unable to attend at that time.

Ofsted believes that schools are best placed to recognise their own strengths and weaknesses. The new inspection system puts the onus on a school to demonstrate that it can analyse and interpret data to diagnose where its strengths and weaknesses are. These judgements must be recorded in the school self-evaluation form (SEF).

The SEF asks schools to comment and make judgements on:

- the standards learners reach as indicated by their test results, taking account of; any significant variations between groups of learners, subjects, courses and key stages; trends over time; comparisons with other schools; whether learners reach challenging targets.

- learners' progress relative to their starting points and capabilities, with significant variations between groups of learners.

These briefings will provide an opportunity to discuss the new style 2005 PANDA report and Fischer Family Trust analysis to support self-evaluation. Both focus particularly on contextual vale-added analysis in Keystage 2. Therefore these briefings are particularly appropriate for schools with children in Y6. Sessions will be running on all the dates printed above and at the end of this flyer.

Schools should bring a copy of their own new style 2005 PANDA and the analysis to support self-evaluation (the link for this is on the key data sheet). These documents will be explained and schools will have an opportunity to scrutinise and discuss their own data. These briefing sessions will provide important information for Norfolk primary schools and we look forward to seeing you at one of the sessions.
