The focus of this workshop will be on Learning Centred Leadership and Distributed Leadership and it will be led by Professor Geoff Southworth (National College for School Leadership).

It should prove to be an excellent opportunity to reflect on the latest thinking on how school leaders can improve learning and teaching. A particular emphasis will be on exploring the notion of distributed leadership and how it can support leadership teams.

Geoff Southworth directs the NCSL's research programmes, as well as the communication of research findings and contemporary leadership thinking to school leaders. Geoff is committed to evidence-informed practice, school-based enquiry

and practitioner involvement in research. Before Geoff joined the NCSL, he was Professor of Education at Reading University. He has been a teacher, deputy and headteacher, as well as a research lecturer at

Cambridge University.
