## **Promoting Positive Behaviour for Secondary Teachers and Teaching Assistants**

These one-day practical workshops are intended to give teachers and teaching assistants in mainstream and special schools an intensive opportunity to examine and try out classroom behaviour management techniques. The day will involve participants in discussion of low level non-verbal and verbal de-escalation and intervention strategies as well as some analysis of dealing with more challenging conflict situations.

The course objectives are to:

- better understand the use of low key intervention and de-escalation strategies
- be better equipped to deal with more challenging conflict situations.
