We are pleased to offer a limited number of funded places on this three-day non-residential course provided by the National Autistic Society. The course will be presented by Dr Gary Mesibov, Director of Division TEACCH, North Carolina and will be held on **12th -14th October 2005** in Nottingham.

The purpose of this course is to familiarise participants with autism and various approaches to working with people with autism and their families. Structured Teaching, Division TEACCH's main intervention approach will be emphasised and participants will see how it has evolved in response to the unique needs of the autistic population. Aspects of applying TEACCH techniques to classroom instruction will be highlighted.

The course is suitable for SENCOs, teachers and teaching assistants working with children with ASD. Places are limited to one per school. **Schools must have an identified need and applications must be endorsed by the school's Pupil Entitlement Support Officer (PESO).
