A one-year Advanced Certificated distance learning course provided by the University of Birmingham. This course is offered to teachers and SENCOs employed by the LEA on a full-time basis in primary, secondary and special schools. This course is supported by Standards Fund (subject to confirmation of funding for 2005/2006). Course fees will be paid by the LEA. Expenses relating to the purchase of books and supply, travel and accommodation for residential weekends/tutorials are not covered. Funding is for one year of study only. The closing date for applications for LEA funding is 25th March 2005.

Please note that there is an expectation that schools and candidates agreeing to be funded for an Advanced Professional Qualification will complete the course once it has started. In exceptional circumstances a replacement candidate could be substituted prior to the commencement of the course in the autumn term.
