### Norfolk Regional Support Group (RSG) - Free training and networking sessions for early foreign language learning (ELL)

**What is offered?** Five different sessions per year are offered to give a hands-on overview of ELL resources and methodology together with a chance to network with other practitioners.

**Who can attend?** All involved in, or starting to become involved in, teaching languages to young learners: nursery, foundation, KS1 & KS2 class teachers; student teachers; learning support assistants; headteachers and governors.

**How are sessions funded?** The FREE RSG sessions are funded by the DfES and co-ordinated by the National Advisory Centre on Early Language Learning (NACELL) in support of the National Languages Strategy.
