The main purpose of this half-day course is to assist headteachers and other key players in schools in preparing for inspection, using the Section 5 Ofsted inspection framework which came into use from the autumn term of 2005. By the end of the session, participants will be aware of the short, medium and longer term practical tasks required to ensure that a school is fully prepared for a short notice inspection.

Practicalities to be covered include: essential information to have to hand as 'a ready pack' whilst awaiting notification; effective SEF writing - the 'do's' and 'don'ts'; managing on-going self-evaluation and also selective evidence gathering from all stakeholders. We shall also have a brief look at useful evidence linked to outcomes of 'Every Child Matters'.

Participants are encouraged to bring along their current Self-Evaluation Form (SEF) to refer to during the session.
