Gain an understanding in the use of insurance policies (including the use of Block Journey Insurance and those provided by ski companies) with regard to ski visits from Gerry Baker, NCC Risk and Insurance. Understand the NCC procedures for reporting incidents and accidents followed by a question and answer session with Paul Commins, NCC Health and Safety Department.

Please ensure that you bring all paperwork in connection with any planned ski visit, copies of information for parents to share. You should also come equipped with suitable clothing for a practical ski session.
