This long course "Developing Inclusive Practice: the Role of the SENCO", provided by the University of East Anglia, is suitable for practising primary or secondary teachers employed by Norfolk County Council on a full-time basis. It is designed for SENCOs, although it will be useful for other staff. Successful completion will qualify you for a Post-graduate Certificate.

The course will run between autumn 2006 and summer 2007, and will involve attendance at the UEA on ten twilight and five whole-day sessions, dates to be advised.

There is an expectation that schools and candidates agreeing to be funded for an Advanced Professional Qualification will complete the course once it has started. In exceptional circumstances a replacement candidate could be substituted prior to the start of the course. Places are limited to **one per school** and those schools not previously represented on the course will be given priority.

If you are selected for funding you will need to complete the UEA application form.

Further details will be forwarded to you, if you are accepted for funding, as soon as they become available.
