This course is supported by Standards Fund. Course fees will be paid by the Local Authority, subject to confirmation of funding for 2006/2007. Expenses relating to the purchase of books, supply, travel and accommodation for residential weekends/tutorials are not covered. The funding is for one year of study only. The closing date for applications for Norfolk Children's Services funding is 1st March 2006.

Please note that there is an expectation that schools and candidates agreeing to be funded for an Advanced Professional Qualification will complete the course once it has started. In exceptional circumstances a replacement candidate could be substituted prior to the commencement of the course in the autumn term.
