This one-day self-evaluation and development course for headteachers, senior managers, SENCOs and teachers from primary schools is delivered by Norfolk Education Advisory Services to OFSTED specifications. It may also be of interest to governors, for information.

This course aims to:

- ensure that secure and consistent judgements are made when evaluating the progress of pupils with special educational needs in mainstream schools
- to help schools become more effective in evaluating the impact of their own provision for such pupils
- to develop a common understanding about what is effective provision for pupils with special educational needs
- to ensure the use of common evaluative approaches.

The course assumes that participants have a working knowledge and experience of the issues surrounding the support of pupils with special educational needs. Participants will also need a basic familiarity with some of the recent legislation in this field.
