In brief, Neuro Linguistic Programming (NLP) is a unique approach to understanding how we learn, how we communicate with others and helps focus on the verbal and non verbal messages we send out when communicating. It will help teachers to understand how and why they reach certain decisions and why they react in certain ways. It can improve the atmosphere and ethos both in the classroom and in the staffroom, bringing improvements in morale. It will enable all to become more effective in delivering high quality lessons and high quality training, inset sessions, and one to one relationships with students and staff.

Participants will cover:

- the core principles of NLP communication;
- techniques for core body language communication to improve rapport with others;
- use of NLP techniques in the classroom;
- understanding how others react to your style.

The aim is that, by the end of the course, participants will have:

- practical ways to apply the NLP communication model;
- a clear understanding of how to improve professional effectiveness;
- effective tools for improving personal well-being;
- enhanced presentational skills.
