## **RE: Audit of TOP PLAY and TOP Sport**

You may recall that we wrote to you in November 2001 regarding the TOPs programme in Norfolk schools. This audit is imperative in order to get a true picture of the current level of activity and resources so that we can continue to drive developments in PE and Sport forward.

Time is running out as lottery funding for Norfolk will finish in May 2002. If you have already been trained and have received a bag, then we need to know whether the bag and the cards are still being used or if the cards have disappeared.

In view of the limited amount of time left in which Norfolk schools can gain access to lottery funding for the programme, it is imperative that schools wishing to become involved complete the audit and contact me as a matter of urgency. The school will receive a free bag of sports equipment to the value of £550 and a set of resource cards for the teachers. This will be accompanied by training and support at a local level.
