The session will include:

- The Norfolk early years STAIR (supporting transition and inclusion record) as well as the latest advice and guidance to support high quality transitions into school, including for children with SEND
- Advice and guidance on tailoring provision to build an inclusive EYFS curriculum around children's starting points
- An opportunity for you to think about and plan for the individual and cohort needs, with a focus on the prime areas of the EYFS
- Evidence based support for Speech, Language and Communication needs, including the Norfolk Communication hub offer.

Delegates will leave the session with:

- Improved knowledge and awareness about Norfolk early years transition expectations, including for children with SEND
- Increased understanding about how to build an inclusive EYFS curriculum
- Increased confidence to meet the needs of your incoming Reception cohort
- Enhanced awareness of local support for children with additional needs.
