Literacy and Numeracy Update

We are pleased to be able to tell you that additional funding from Standards Fund 301 (Primary Literacy & Numeracy Strategy) has recently been allocated to all schools to support the work of English and Maths Co-ordinators.

In addition, for those schools with Year 6 pupils, a sum for Booster funding has also been allocated. Details are as follows:

a. Supporting the work of English and Maths Co-ordinators

All schools will be allocated the sum of £290 to pay for supply cover for Maths and English co-ordinators. It is intended that they may use this time to develop their role further in line with the school's priorities.

b. Allocation of Booster Funding

Schools with Year 6 pupils will receive additional funding in order to support Booster groups in the spring term 2004. The funding is designed to support those schools with more than 6-8 pupils in a Year 6 class who are likely to be borderline level 3-4. In Norfolk, however, we will once again offer funding to **all** schools with Year 6 pupils, even those where the cohort size is small, and less than 6-8 pupils. It will enable mathematics and/or English subject leaders in those smaller schools to plan booster sessions within the daily lessons. Those schools with Year 6 cohorts of 30 or more will need to organise booster provision both within and outside literacy and mathematics lessons due to the number of pupils that are likely to find them beneficial.

As in previous years, a formula has been used that weights 50% of the allocation to pupil number and current standards of attainment, and the remaining 50% to all schools by pupil number only.
