This course aims to help support staff and teachers in **Pre-school**, **Primary and High** schools, understand and develop strategies to meet the needs of children with cerebral palsy in their school/setting.

**Day 1** is a very full day, involving contributions from a number of speakers. **Day 2** takes place a few weeks later, to allow participants time to consider matters related to their particular circumstances/child in the context of learning from day 1, and is a more interactive day of hands-on workshops where you can discuss the needs of the particular children in your school/setting with Health & Education Practitioners and try equipment, hardware and software. You will be able to participate in all the following workshops on:

- Physiotherapy
