We would like schools in each area to contribute to a range of activities representing the five themes as follows:

- Investigating learning/thinking skills
- PSHE/Citizenship
- Biodiversity/environment
- Communication
- Creativity

At each venue there will be floor space for the performances and presentations, and a good-sized area for display boarding and tables.

You may already have decided to offer to contribute to events at the Forum in Norwich. In addition we are inviting schools from all areas to take part in our local events. Having received your offer to contribute to one of the events we will try to ensure that we have a selection of activities and displays to reflect the five themes and represent the range of schools across the area. It is likely that displays will have to be set up during the day before your local area event is to take place and dismantled at the end of the day. One of the team preparing the celebration will contact you about your contribution. There will be performances every half hour during the day between 10.00 and 14.00. Performances should be between 15 and 20 minutes in length. Light refreshments will be provided for children and adults taking part.

We will also need a number of stewards to help with organisation of events at each venue talking to visitors and leafleting the public. We would be grateful for any staff, parents or governors who would be willing to help on the day. Please indicate on the attached proforma.

If you are unable to participate in any of the events at the Forum or area events, please open your doors to the community and celebrate what is happening in your school. Some ideas for what you might do were included in the letter sent to schools last term. Nearer the celebration, we will be contacting all schools to provide details of their events, so that full details of all that is going on across the county will be well publicised.
