Teaching Assistant Courses



Teaching Assistants are a vital part of the education system and can play an important role in helping childen to develop and meet their full potential.

Teaching Assistants Level 2 - 20 weeks x 3 hrs + Information session

This course is ideal for volunteers or teaching assistants who are new to the role. You will gain knowledge to support your role in a variety of areas including safeguarding, child development and positive behaviour management.

You will also develop your digital skills and reflect on other aspects of employment such as time management and career goals, gaining qualifications in these too.

You must be volunteering in a school, or in paid employment as a teaching assistant, for a minimum of 6 hours per week.

Fee £1,265, free if you earn less than £20,319 or are unemployed and receive a means tested benefit

Teaching Assistants Level 3 - 20 weeks x 3 hrs + Information session

Suitable for experienced teaching assistants who are employed or have a long-standing volunteering placement. You will gain knowledge to support your role in a variety of areas with mandatory and optional units to suit your specific job role.

You will also develop your digital skills, become aware of how to support children with dyslexia and reflect on your own practice, gaining qualifications in these too.

Fee £1,987, free if you earn less than £20,319 or are unemployed and receive a means tested benefit.

Teaching Assistants Level 4 (Higher Level Teaching Assistant) 10 weeks x 2 hrs + Information session

Gain a qualification to support the class teacher with daily lessons. You must be employed as a teaching assistant, have English and maths at Level 2, as well as your Teaching Assistant Level 3 qualification.

You will develop your knowledge of team working, planning, and delivering activities to individuals, groups or the whole class and providing provision for pupils with special educational needs and disabilities.

Fee £1,265, Advanced Learning Loan available.
