Communicating Matters



Communicating Matters

This training is aimed at all practitioners working with young children in early years settings (nurseries, playgroups, pre-schools, accredited childminders working in approved childminding networks, schools in the independent, private or voluntary sectors and maintained schools). It is the result of a project, Communicating Matters, commissioned by the DfES which helped promote the development of communication and language for all children in the early years.

Communicating Matters has three aims:

1. To deepen practitioners understanding of children's communication and language, particularly between the ages of three and five years.
2. To deepen practitioners understanding of how their own communicative behaviour affects children's use and display of communicative behaviours.
3. To help practitioners reflect on and develop their practice to promote children's communication and language more effectively.

Now is your opportunity to apply for **Module One: An introduction to communication and language in early years settings.**

This module focuses on the basic elements of communication and language and language development and communication in early years settings. The module runs over 5 x 3 hour sessions, running over 6 weeks. There is a 2 week break between session three and four to enable you to complete some work in your setting.

The course will be led by Susan Lyon, a Speech and Language Therapist from Great Yarmouth and Waveney PCT and Mel Sessions, an Advisory Teacher in Suffolk.
