This is one of a series of specialist conferences, organised by the Norfolk Migrant Worker Partnership, to promote good practice in the areas of equalities and diversity, which are held in different localities across the county.

The conference will be free-of-charge, and will be of interest to headteachers or senior staff in all schools, but particularly in schools catering for children from migrant worker families.

Themes cover all areas of the County Council's activity, and this conference is on the theme of education. For this reason, this flyer is being circulated via the e-courier, so that schools interested in attending can plan ahead for the new school year.

The morning's programme will comprise three main elements, as follows:

Children's Services Equalities and Inclusion Support/English Language Support Service: overview of educational provision for EAL, diversity, equalities.
