#### BASIC EXPEDITION LEADER AWARD B.E.L.A.

This is a training course for teachers or youth workers leading young people on expedition or training them for expeditions. The qualification covers what is recognised by The Duke of Edinburgh's Award, as Normal or Open ground so is suitable for Bronze and Silver level expeditions. B.E.L.A. is a nationally recognised qualification moderated by the British Sports Trust. This course will be particularly focused on the requirements for leading The Duke of Edinburgh's Award groups.
