Leading Learning in the Early Years

This is a new and exciting programme for headteachers and deputies of Norfolk schools with a Foundation Stage. It is designed to broaden the perspectives of headteachers and deputies in the leadership and management of the Foundation Stage by:

- visiting Foundation Stage settings in other LEAs, engaging in debate about common issues with colleagues across the County, listening and debating issues with key note speakers with a national reputation in early years education, reflecting on the quality of the Foundation Stage in their own school and engage in problem solving activities to raise expectations further.

The programme will take place during the summer term and autumn term 2004, and spring term 2005. We will be limiting the group to around 25 headteachers.

Aims: This programme will enable headteachers to:

- Consider views of leadership which take learning as the focal point for school improvement ;
- Visit a range of Foundation Stage settings in other LEAs and reflect on improvement issues with colleagues in those schools;
- Attend a residential conference to share experiences with colleagues and identify an improvement project in the Foundation Stage of their own school.
