## This one day course has been designed by the RGS-IBG Expedition Advisory Centre in association with the LEA Outdoor Education Advisers Panel for any LEA school leader who wishes to plan and lead or accompany an overseas expedition or fieldwork.

The Royal Geographical Society (with Institute of British Geographers) Expedition Advisory Centre is the world's leading centre for information, training and advice to anyone undertaking scientific or adventurous expeditions overseas. Each year it assists more than 500 teams in planning and preparing their expeditions.

This new course for is for teachers who plan and lead overseas expeditions and fieldwork, including those using a contracted expeditions company. The course is also useful for a school's EVC.
