The Artist

Storyteller and dramatist David Farmer (Artistic Director of Tiebreak Theatre from 1981 to 2005) is the author of best-selling book "101 Drama Games and Activities" and was a mentor in Norfolk schools for Drama for Learning and Creativity (D4LC). He has a current enhanced CRB check.

Programme

"Frog Stories" begins with a 20-minute storytelling session in Assembly to the whole school or year group concerned. This performance also includes participation through songs and drama techniques. It is followed up with one-hour practical workshops using drama games and techniques to explore the stories. Pupils have the opportunity to act out scenes and play different characters using improvisation, movement and dialogue.
