To all MFL Heads of Departments in High Schools

As a courtesy, and for your information, we wish to inform you of the series of cluster meetings we have planned for the summer term 2008. As you may be aware, there are 13 area clusters within the county, varying quite considerably in size, and usually consisting of 3 or 4 high school clusters together with 'feeder' primaries for each high school. Therefore, there will be 13 dates and venues from the end of April to July this year.

It is government policy that studying a foreign language for a cumulative 60 minutes a week in KS2 will become an entitlement by September 2009. It is likely to be statutory soon after. You may be aware that a KS2 Framework for Languages was published in 2006, and that over the last two years we have offered all primaries detailed training on this and primary methodology. We continue to run very well attended language improvement classes throughout the county.

The teaching and learning of a foreign language has increasingly become part of the curriculum in most of our county primary schools, at least in Y5 and 6, but also in Y3 and 4. Over the last two years most high school clusters have met and have agreed on a transition language (usually French) to be studied for at least two out of the four KS2 years with Spanish, German and a language investigation approach being used for the other two years. There is clearly much good practice in the primaries that the high schools will naturally wish to build on.

It is with this principle in mind that we are aiming to facilitate communication and dialogue between KS2 and KS3 language teachers. Each primary school has been asked to identify a 'Subject Leader' to represent their school at a cluster meeting. It is intended that at our first meeting we will conduct an audit of primary language provision in each school, in order to provide information that will be useful in discussions with high school MFL departments. Following on from this, together we will be able to identify the future needs, training and support. At these meetings we also intend to present Norfolk's bank of questions in French for KS2/3 transition purposes. It is hoped that some schools will agree to trial these questions after the meeting.

As previously stated, we are sharing this information with you about our transition ideas and the importance we attach to our primary and high schools working together on foreign language issues. It is very much appreciated that for our high school colleagues the summer term is one of extreme workload and examination commitments. For this reason, we are not able to extend a formal invitation to high school MFL departments during the months of May and June. However, should you wish to attend a cluster meeting in April or July, we would be delighted to see you and could pay a half day's supply per high school. Dates and venues for the summer term meetings are attached.

Second cluster meetings are planned for the autumn term and it is hoped that our high school colleagues will be able to attend these. Further information will follow later in the school year.

In the meantime, we hope you feel encouraged to become involved in this type of KS2/3 transition dialogue in cluster groups. Indeed, many of you will be working along these lines already and will hopefully be able to contribute some feedback and suggestions.

We look forward to working with all schools in Norfolk to develop exciting, cohesive and cross phase language provision.
