National Healthy School Status

There is now a national framework through which to recognise the achievement of schools supporting children and young people to be healthy. This is based on a range of criteria across four key themes:

- Personal Social and Health Education
- Healthy Eating
- Physical Activity
- Emotional Health and Well-being

Most colleagues who have looked at the criteria for the status have found it very clear and a useful umbrella to acknowledge all the work going on in schools to promote health and wellbeing – including that of School Sports Partnerships and School Travel Planning.

It is especially helpful that the criteria for this status link clearly to the new Ofsted Inspection Framework for Schools. The new status is very much a framework to recognise a whole range of activity being undertaken in schools.

The Healthy Norfolk Schools Team is supporting all the schools they are working with to achieve this national status which does not involve laborious evidence gathering but is based on a simple self-evaluation model.

We know in that in many of our schools there is a huge amount of work going on and would really encourage you to join Healthy Norfolk Schools. As soon as schools join the programme they receive a certificate to display in school and a logo to use on all school correspondence and publications. They are also entitled to support from the team.
