I am writing to invite you to an important event for all primary Headteachers.

In response to *Excellence and Enjoyment – A strategy for primary schools*, the LEA has produced a draft document outlining the Norfolk Primary Strategy. At these meetings it is our intention to consult you about the draft and outline in greater detail some key elements of support.

Central to the focus on leadership is a funded programme to focus on strengthening collaborative leadership. I hope, therefore, you will be able to attend and you are strongly advised to select one of the sessions running for your area.

This strategy is going to be the core of the work of the primary team of advisers in the next few years. Ray Leeke, David Orsborne (Primary Principal Advisers) and Chris Snudden (Primary Strategy Manager) will be leading this. They can answer any queries you may have on this excellent development.
