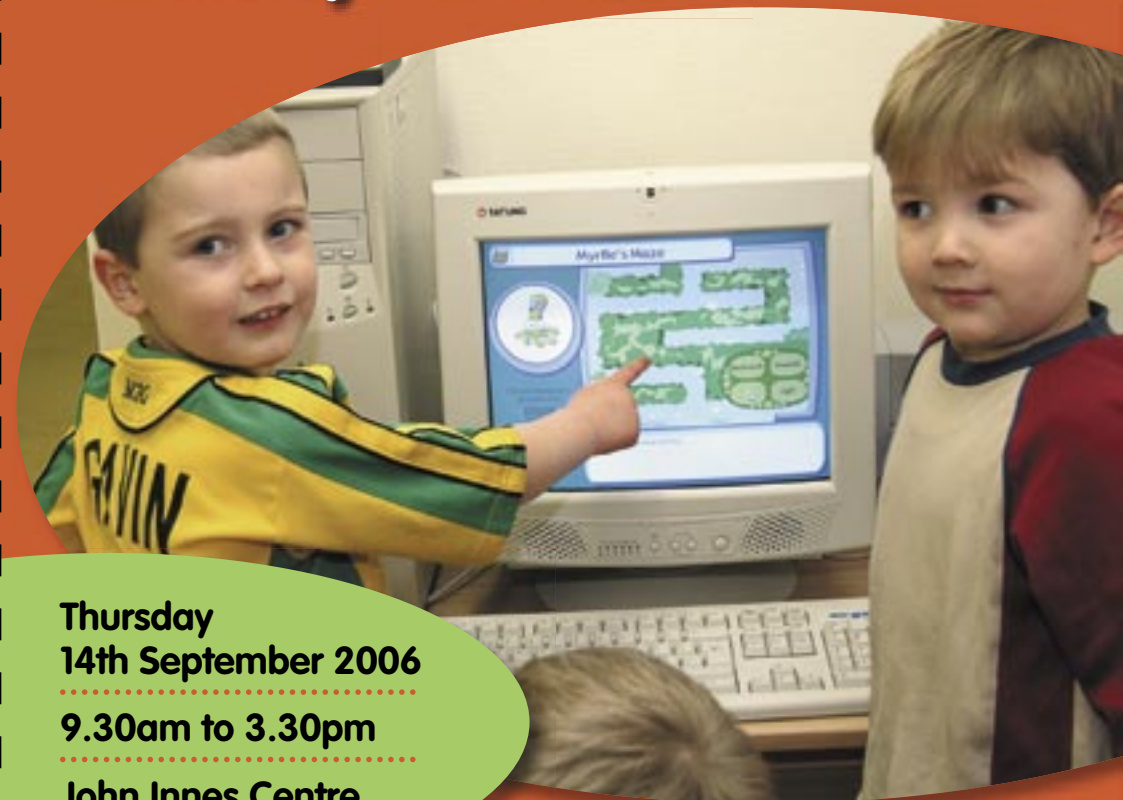

### Workshops

#### Digital Cameras - Sheila Denny
