Footprints is a large-scale exhibition revealing the talent and creativity of young people from six schools in Norfolk. Taking inspiration from the Anglo-Saxon and Viking history of East Anglia, each participating school has created their own works of art using many different styles and techniques.



This stunningly imaginative, mixed-media exhibition includes painting, pottery, printmaking, puppetry, ceramics, sculpture, film-making, graffiti art, jewellery design, textiles and much more.



Footprints is the culmination of a Creative Partnerships project involving almost a thousand young people aged 4 -18. Creative Partnerships is a creative education programme which aims to nurture young people's potential through partnerships between schools, cultural organisations, businesses and individuals.
