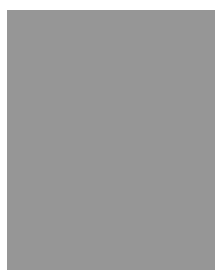
The Life of Mammals

The weekend will include:

- A look at herbivores, insectivores, predators and prey, and consider the features that adapt our mammals to survive in their environment.
- Trapping and release of small mammals.
- An early morning deer watch.
- A boat trip to Blakeney Point for the seals.
- Identifying and reconstructing small mammal remains from owl pellet analysis.
- Bats and batwatching.
- Other themes from the BBC series 'The Life of Mammals' as presented by David Attenborough.

The course is suitable for anyone, of any age, who would like the opportunity to learn a little more about the lives of some of our common mammals.

We are sure it will be a weekend to remember.

The inclusive course fee is just £130 per person

(Based on two people sharing a room)
