### Live Music Week - 18, 19 and 21 July 2006

Live music week gives children and young people the opportunity to hear live music performed by the Norfolk Music Service. This year performances are only available for part of the week and the arrangements are slightly different so please read this letter carefully.

In Live Music Week this year we will be providing two types of musical performances:

### Live Music - Learning to Play (45mins)

### Live Music – The Concert (45mins)

Live Music – Learning to Play will be a musical performance by one or more Music Service staff already teaching in your school. Its main purpose is to raise the profile of the musical instruments already taught in school. We hope to demonstrate the wider musical context of the instruments and give other children the opportunity to consider if they would like to join this part of the achievement and enjoyment strand. This option is 45 minutes long and costs £22.50 per teacher for up to and including 3 teachers.

Live Music – The Concert will be a performance in the more conventional sense by either a solo or small group of musicians as requested. This option is 45 minutes long and costs £80 for a soloist and £150 for a small group.

Charges are based upon the Live Music experience most appropriate for your children and are unrelated to audience size. They are most suitable for KS1 KS2 and Year 7 and of course schools may well decide to combine and share the responsibility and cost of the event. Please remember however that for Live Music Week our staff are in the role of performers and all audiences, whatever their size, will need to be managed by school staff. Music staff will not be able to concentrate on performing whilst dealing with a disruptive child or group of children.
