Come and find out by investigating with us the Bolingbroke family – owners of Strangers' Hall in the Victorian era.

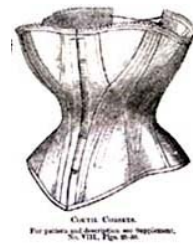


Strangers' Hall,
