Cornelia Parker: Installations

22 November 2004 – 27 February 2005

(A Tate Partnership Scheme Exhibition)

The show includes two of Cornelia Parker's dramatic installations - *Cold Dark Matter: An Exploded View* 1991 and *Thirty Pieces of Silver* 1988-89. *Cold Dark Matter* was created by blowing up a garden shed filled with assorted objects – ranging from bicycles and boxing gloves to hair curlers and hockey sticks - then suspending the distorted fragments around a single light bulb. *Thirty Pieces of Silver* was created by crushing a thousand silver objects with a steamroller and then suspending them. A show to make you think!

A chance for teachers to have a tour of the exhibition and collect resource materials (which include a large-sized poster of Cornelia Parker's exploded shed, with background information and curriculum-related suggestions for the classroom).
