I hope you enjoyed a wonderful vacation. I am writing to update you about the Norfolk Music Service, please find enclosed the following helpful information.

#### A Yearly Planner:

The planner enables you to identify the teaching weeks and track musical opportunities and events available throughout the year. On the reverse side we have written all the performing ensembles available for ease of access to information

### An Updated Service Level Agreement (previously emailed to schools):

Several colleagues responded to our questionnaire to say they had no information to hand about the Music Service. The Service Level Agreement (SLA) is a vital document that expresses the understanding of the partnership between the Music Service and schools.

#### An Ensemble Flyer:

There are a range of weekly ensembles that we would like to encourage all instrumentalists to join – all at very reasonable prices.

#### Learn to play the Lute:

The Lute Society is very pleased to develop 4 lute players in the County. The Lute Society will provide the instruments and we thought a KS2 pupil or a pair of pupils would be one possibility. Each lute is hand made and takes about 8 - 12 months to complete therefore the project requires a child or children who will still be in school next September. The Lute Society is keen to support anyone who is interested in learning to play and welcomes interest from all adults in school. The lute makers are Norwich based and would particularly welcome adults, families and carers who would like to learn to make their own lute for a member of the family to play on. #### An Updated Schedule of Sing Up:

Sing Up is the Music Manifesto National Singing Programme, and is backed by Government. It aims to put high-quality everyday singing back into all English primaryage schools and the wider community. All the CPD training and events you see identified are free of charge. As ever we look forward to a successful year and continue to face the rising costs of running the Service. You may have already received my previous letter outlining a 10% increase in costs and I can now confirm the following prices for this academic year.

**Instrumental teaching** for all group sizes is £28.50 per hour.

#### Instrumental hire remains as follows

- Instruments up to the value of £150 will cost £15.00 per term
- Instruments between the value of £150 and £400 will cost £25.00 per term
- Instruments over the value of £400 will cost £30.00 per term

Please note the new arrangements identified in the Service Level Agreement that instruments are hired for each term and charged per term. There are no refunds if the child stops the lessons mid term.

#### **Curriculum teaching** is £36.00 per hour **Early Years teaching** is £22.00 per 40 min session **Ensemble Membership** is as follows

- £25.00 for any individual ensemble
- £40.00 for family membership to any ensembles

Prices exclude the CYO and ICYO that have discrete membership fees.

As I am sure you appreciate we have worked very hard to keep these increases to a minimum as we still aim to provide a high level of service for as many children and young people as possible. We still believe this to be very good value for money.

I understand and sympathise with headteachers who are concerned about the financial situation of many families and fear the opportunity to learn an instrument may be too exclusive. However please remember the change in the law regarding charging for instrumental lessons.

- 1. Vocal lessons are now equal to instrumental lessons and are to be charged in the same way. There was an irregularity that has now been cleared by this amendment.
- 2. All restrictions on the group sizes has been lifted (including vocal) so that groups do not have to consist of four children or less.

Therefore 7 children at beginner level sharing a 30-minute lesson each week will be sharing £14.25 and could be facing a bill of only £2.04 per week.
