Apart from this Steve has written fantasy and SF for teenagers, adult and teen horror, romance, mainstream fiction for pre-teens, fiction and non-fiction for younger readers and poetry for all ages. To date he has published thirty-nine titles and numerous short stories and poems.

The conference will also include opportunities for hearing about the most recent QCA/NCSL conferences concerned with the latest research and thinking about effective innovation in learning, teaching and the curriculum.
