Schools' Biodiversity Project 'Nature in Norwich' Photography Competition 2004

Background

Norwich 21, a non-profit organisation addressing Local Agenda 21 issues, is launching a photography competition for KS2 - KS4 as part of its schools' biodiversity project in Norwich. The competition will also be open to the wider community.

Entry

Entrants are required to produce a photographic image and short piece of writing which has been inspired by the picture. The theme is 'Nature in Norwich' and pupils are encouraged to utilise their school grounds for creating imaginative and stimulating photos. The competition can be used to complement any project that is being undertaken by the school to improve school grounds for wildlife.

The use of digital cameras and digital software technology is encouraged, but not essential for entry. Use of the Norwich Arts Centre Mobile Media Unit and specialised tutor can be arranged if required. Winning entries will be displayed in the Forum during the last week of summer term after which it will be taken to various other venues in Norfolk.

Participation in this project supports Education for Sustainable Development as it encourages pupils to value & appreciate local wildlife. Other National Curriculum links include:
