This years annual PE and School Sport Conference is taking place on September 29<sup>th</sup> at Easton College. The conference has a subtle theme of **PE and Sport - Supporting Learning**. Following feedback from last year's conference we have included workshops relating specifically to the Foundation Stage (Action Kids 600, Start to Play, and Busy Feet and a workshop showcasing resources for Early Years from a local specialist company).

The Conference will also see the launch of our "*Power of Five* " Campaign which seeks to promote the positive benefits of getting involved in PE and sport, joining up a number of key initiatives and government agendas through a simple campaign. The Conference will also see the introduction of the new *Activity Trackers* and *Competition Calendar* as well as the launch of Cimex's new Games making software called "*Go Play!*" which was partly developed in association with Norfolk.

The conference will feature and showcase new activities such as *Disc Sport, Rock-it-Ball, Extreme Golf and Futsal* as well as new resources for cross-curricular work such as *Health Matters and Freddy Fitness*. Dance workshops will focus on cross-curricular work too and we are hoping to be able to offer taster workshops relating to Romans, Egyptians and Greeks from a local Dance Artist.

Supporting the Learning is also a feature of the workshop on "Playing For Success", where sport is the primary driver in engaging pupils with Literacy, Numeracy and ICT to raise standards of attainment and achievement. The session will feature input from Norfolk's highly acclaimed PfS Team.

We hope to see you at this years Conference. The Conference only costs £60 per delegate and supply cover is available by contacting your School's Partnership Development Manager (PDM). All 8 PDM's are supporting the event by allowing their schools to attend and claim the £140 supply cover contribution back through them.
