In such schools the 'premises manager' is likely to be the headteacher or someone with delegated responsibility for day to day site management and maintenance issues such as the health and safety co-ordinator or site manager.

At the end of the training, delegates should understand Norfolk County Council's systems for managing:

- Asbestos
- Fire safety, including hot works
- Contractors
- Legionella
- Statutory inspections of plant & equipment
