- Collages could be individual, group or class efforts. The collage should be a **picture without text** based on the theme: '**The Natural World**'. Examples could be:
 - single or group depiction of plant/animal life
 - a landscape/underwater scene etc.
- At least 50% of the collage should be made from waste paper/packaging containing written text in a language or languages other than English e.g. penne, baguette, Schwarzbrot!
 - This international text waste paper/packaging could include: magazines & newspapers, tickets, holiday brochures, fruit labels, pasta/cereal/cosmetics/ toy/shampoo/fast food packets etc. (but not text printed from the internet!)
 - The collage should not have words actually written on it in a foreign language...the only text should be an integral part of the packaging used to create the picture
 - A collage could be any size but the final photographs will be mounted as A1... (landscape or portrait) and so larger collages will photograph better.
- Collages will be judged on:
 - 1) Artistic composition
 - 2) Imaginative use of international text/waste paper as collage materials
