This is the Norfolk Primary National Strategy training programme open to all schools to support improvement in provision to raise standards.

The content of the training programme 2008 -2009 is drawn from the national priorities outlined in the National Strategies Annual Plan and the Standards Funds Grant 1.7. The funding has been allocated to this training programme to further meet the Norfolk priorities for improvement contained within the Norfolk Children's Services Children and Young People's Plan. There is funding for every school to attend core training for assessment and the primary framework and we will be required to track the attendance of every school and report this nationally.

Core training priority 1 - Assessment. For leadership teams the focus is on the strategic implications of the whole assessment agenda – taking assessment for learning to a deeper level, further strengthening and aligning teacher assessment through the use of the assessing pupil progress materials (APP) and the tracking of pupil progress. For teachers the focus is on using the APP materials in order that **every teacher** is able to use the resource confidently for teacher assessment in at least one aspect of reading, writing or mathematics by the end of the academic year. Funding will be provided for up to 5 members of the leadership team (headteacher, senior manager, Mathematics Subject Leader, English Subject Leader, Science Subject Leader) and will be allocated in September.

Core training priority 2 - The Primary Framework. This year the funding is for CPD that focuses on the Primary Framework for teachers of Year 2, 3 and 4 children. It also includes CPD for headteachers and English and Mathematics Subject Leaders to support effective leadership of the school-based elements of this training. Whilst the content of this training will have specific elements that are to do with effective strategies for teaching aspects of English and mathematics, e.g. guided group work, the link will be clearly made to the use of the assessment materials included in the Primary Framework (particularly APP) and work back in school. Please note that every school will receive supply cover for the core training priority 2 following attendance at courses.

Additional training programme open to all schools and places will be allocated in order of application.

The letter outlining the support band for your school will detail the in-school funding to support the mid course tasks and other school-based activity for both assessment and the Primary Framework.

Improving Assessment for Learning

There is an expectation that all schools will attend this training

This course provides Leadership teams with an opportunity to consider the strategic implications of the way forward with assessment. In particular Assessment for Learning and pupil progress tracking in schools with the ultimate goal of improving pupil progression.

This course has 3 elements in which schools are expected to participate:

- a half-day training for leadership teams in the autumn term 08
- school-based activities
- a half-day follow up in the summer term 09

All schools are expected to attend BOTH half day sessions. If the whole leadership team is unable to attend sessions together we would prefer for schools not to send delegates individually but at least in pairs so that discussion and planning time can be used more effectively.

Primary Strategy CPD for literacy and mathematics, linked to Year 2, 3 and 4 training

There is an expectation that all schools will attend this training

This course aims to:

- Embed the use of the Primary Framework in the school improvement cycle
- Strengthen school leadership, particularly leadership of mathematics and English
- Improve day-to-day and periodic assessment through the APP tools and processes
- Improve teaching and learning in key areas of mathematics and English

This course has 9 elements. Schools are expected to participate in all 9 of these elements:

- a half-day CPD for Headteachers (autumn term 08)
- a half-day CPD for mathematics subject leaders (autumn term 08)
- a half-day CPD for literacy subject leaders (autumn term 08)
- day 1 mathematics CPD for one teacher from each of Year 2, 3 and 4
- day 1 literacy CPD for one teacher from each of Year 2, 3 and 4
- school-based tasks for literacy and mathematics – funding for this will be devolved to schools in September
- day 2 mathematics CPD for one teacher from each of Year 2, 3 and 4
- day 2 literacy CPD for one teacher from each of Year 2, 3 and 4
- a half-day follow up CPD for Headteachers (summer term 09)

Funding will be allocated following registration and attendance and all sessions may be booked online.

- consider the way a Block could be planned to include prior learning, assessment for learning and cross-curricular links.
