There will be a substantial time commitment beyond those outlined above to construct the portfolio.

• Any qualified teacher with experience of teaching or coordinating PSHE.

## Cost

 There are no cost implications to participants as the programme is covered by national funding from the DCSF. Supply cover is provided for at least three of the compulsory training days.
