Workshop 1 : Dance Theatre (Thea Soltau)

Dance Consultant Thea says, 'This workshop will introduce you to simple movement tasks. Dance Theatre has the potential to be effective on several levels, primarily it provides powerful visual images which can be used to explore various situations and their ethics, stereotypes, prejudices etc. Because it engages the body it also engages the emotional which encourages empathetic responses and exploration. The workshop will include a balance of practical work (no experience needed!) and a discussion/exchange of ideas and skills'.

Workshop 2 : Visual Arts (Rosie Smith)

Rosie is a Visual Arts Consultant who has led national projects on reconciliation through arts. She has worked with young people in socially deprived areas addressing self-esteem so that young people begin to know they are special and unique. Rosie will encourage you to work with a variety of media and help you to unlock your own creativity and that of the students you work with in RE.

In addition there will be a series of 'Buzz Groups' on themes such as opportunities provided by the new curriculum, assessment for learning and learning outside the classroom.
