As part of our Risk Management programme, we will be conducting surveys of all Norfolk schools during 2002/3.

The primary purpose of this exercise will be to carry out a site survey related to fire, security, premises, H&S management and visitor control measures. The survey will provide risk ranking tables showing the comparative exposure of every school to the risks under consideration.

This information will be of great assistance to us in planning future strategy, reducing risk in schools and setting appropriate premium levels.

The surveys will be conducted by professional surveyors from Zurich Municipal Insurance and will comprise a visit of approximately 2 hrs which will include an interview with the headteacher, H&S Co-ordinator and/or site manager and a physical survey of the site. To assist in this process we would be grateful if the attached questionnaires could be completed and retained for the surveyor during his visit. In addition surveyors will require evidence of H&S Management records as detailed in the questionnaire

This programme draws together a number of previously disparate functions. We are keen to join these together under one risk heading in order to reduce the inconvenience of multiple surveys. We will also be able to provide a more co-ordinated support service to address deficiencies.
