## Subject: Inclusion

Details: The Norwich SEN Network, based at Parkside school, is developing this day around the theme of inclusion. We feel that at present it is one of the greatest challenges to schools and their staff. The day will consist of two key note speakers at the beginning and end of the day plus three sets of workshops. The general theme of the day will be a solution based approach on how children can be included in the education system and not a debate on whether they should be, or where they should be educated. It will look to give staff practical ways in which children with particular difficulties e.g., Autism, ADHD, Behaviour Problems, Emotional Problems, Learning problems, Sensory Needs Etc. can be integrated into the classroom. It cannot look at individual cases but it will give examples of successful practice and give delegates opportunity to network with professionals who deal with these difficulties on a regular basis.

Final details of the day will be sent to people in the week after the February Half Term. However in order to arrange the conference we do need to know how many people are interested in this day. Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
