

PARKING



Early arrival is recommended if you wish to park at the Norwich Sport Village. Please park in the lower left parking area on entering ASDA from the Drayton High Road (A1067), avoiding the main ASDA parking area (see above plan) as this is reserved for ASDA shoppers.

This year, Sweetbriar Retail Park is a free parking area for delegates. Please park on the far side away from the shop fronts. **A free shuttle service will be available at 10 minute intervals from 8.30am to 10.30am between the Sweetbriar Retail Park and Norwich Sport Village.** If you have mobility difficulties and require return transport after 10.30am, please ask at Conference Reception.

If you choose to walk from the Sweetbriar Retail Park to the Norwich Sport Village, then, on leaving the Sweetbriar Retail Park entrance, you should cross the main A140 road at the nearest crossing to walk in safety on the public pathway. You will also need to cross Drayton Road and Boundary Road at the appropriate traffic light crossings.


Alternatively, you may wish to park at B & Q Warehouse, parking on the left side on entering the car park (see above plan). This is a 10 minute walk from the Norwich Sport Village, turning right at the Asda fuel station and walking along the pathway to the right side of the Norwich Sport Village tennis courts.
