

STEP Mathematics

Do you have students wanting or needing to prepare for STEP papers in Mathematics?

Are they working in isolation with guidance from an experienced teacher?

Do you have sufficient material for them?

Wymondham College would like to offer your students the opportunity to meet and interact with similar students from across Norfolk and Suffolk. It is proposed that 4 or 5 seminar sessions are available in 2006. Each session will be for two hours at Wymondham College on a Saturday morning starting at 10.00am. Tea/coffee and biscuits will be provided to help keep those minds rolling along. More importantly this will be at **no cost to your school or the students** – they just have to be able to get to the College.

In advance of each session students will be given 2 or 3 questions from past STEP papers. They will need to prepare and bring their solutions to the meeting. Students will then be given the opportunity to present their solution to the other students, leading to an exchange of ideas and concepts. Further questions can be looked at in the sessions under the guidance of experienced (old!) teachers with the students working in smaller groups.

After the first session it may be appropriate to have some groups of students working on different areas (e.g. Mechanics, STEP II etc). The aim is to fit in with their needs and to give support to you as their teachers. We are offering the expertise of teachers with many (too many) years of teaching and examining of A level Mathematics, Further Mathematics and preparing students for Oxbridge entrance.
