Come and join us for a weekend of culinary discovery as we go in search of some of the hidden tastes of Norfolk's heritage



Born in Dereham 63 years ago, Theo has always enjoyed cooking and the traditional tastes and flavours of his own county. In the mid-70's he and Babs ran their own restaurant, 'The Cavalier', and served a menu of traditional English fare.

This weekend we hope you will discover some of the traditional tastes of the countryside.

You will have a chance to sample many things. . .

- From handmade chocolates to cockles. . .
- Sausages to shrimps. . .
- Try winkles, whelks and crabs. . .
- Yoghurt ice creams and Norfolk apple juice,
- Pork cheese, smoked kippers,
- Norfolk dumplings
- Real ale and local fruit wines
- And much more!

We will visit:

- A variety of local producers and suppliers.
- A smoke house.
- A crab 'factory'.
- A watermill and a brewery.
- Hear talks and see demonstrations of how products are prepared and flavoured.

(There will be opportunities to purchase items to take home.)

BUT – we will not be teaching you how to cook!

The course is suitable for anyone, of any age, with an interest in the tastes and food of Norfolk and the countryside. (Although we welcome vegetarians or vegans this weekend will probably not be particularly suitable for them).

It is designed to be a weekend of fun, relaxation and enjoyment for those who like to try new things and learn a bit more about our food on the way.

The inclusive course fee is just £130 per person (Based on two people sharing a room)

This includes a sherry reception on Friday evening, all meals, tea/coffee, accommodation and tuition.

Accommodation

For the comfort of everyone, numbers on this weekend will be limited to approximately 25 persons.

Some accommodation is in twin-bedded rooms and some in larger, multi-bed rooms, which would be suitable for a family group where parents are sharing with their children, or two or three friends together, or a couple on their own.

It always helps us if two friends are willing to share a room.

There is ample shared bathroom and toilet accommodation (as befits a true country house weekend). But please bring your own towels and soap.

Please note: NO SMOKING is allowed inside Holt Hall.

Holt Hall is situated one mile to the north of Holt in North Norfolk. Access is via either the Kelling Road (main entrance) or Cley Road. Holt itself can be reached along the A148 from King's Lynn or B1149 from Norwich.

Holt Hall is fully licensed and wines and spirits may be purchased if required.
