To All High Schools

Over the next few months we plan to survey all high schools about the relationship between their current technology facilities and curriculum needs.

This will be conducted by Mr Kevin Cowan who has many years of experience of working in technology education and now is employed by Norfolk County Council as a consultant. Kevin would like to work closely with your head of technology in this.

We envisage that the most effective way of doing this would be to look around the technology areas of your school with an opportunity for your head of technology and others to show us how the school currently uses its facilities. We also would like, if possible, to include the views of staff and students on the effectiveness of these facilities as well as suggested improvements and future requirements.

We expect the visit to your school to take about two hours. The outcomes will be used, alongside other data, to inform our plans for Building Schools for the Future and for mainstream capital programmes in the period 2011-14. We very much hope that you will be able to accommodate this important work.
